48th 4-Ball Scramble

July 17th-19th, 2026

Tee Boxes

Men 65 and older : **Red Tees** first nine holes, White Tees second nine holes

Men under 65 : White Tees first nine holes, **Blue Tees** second nine holes

Women 40 and older : **Red Tees** all 18 holes

Women under 40 : **Red Tees** first nine holes, White Tees second nine holes

Scramble Rules:

In fairways, roughs, and bunkers: One club length, no closer to the hole & must stay in the same particular cut of grass or within the bunker.

On the Green: One scorecard length, no closer to the hole.

Water hazards - (Holes 1 & 9) shall be considered Lateral water hazards with 3 drop options:

1. Take drop backwards of the line from the hole to the entry point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard – 1 penalty stroke
2. Take a drop at the site of the last stroke (if on the tee box, may tee it up) – 1 penalty stroke
3. Take a drop within two club lengths of the entry point (i.e. where the ball crossed the margin of the hazard) no closer to the hole – 1 penalty stroke

Ground Under Repair Holes 5 & 6 - The old pond between holes 5 & 6 will be played as Ground Under Repair with a designated drop zone painted for each hole. YOU MUST USE THE DROP ZONE. Please do not play from within the old pond.

Out-Of-Bounds: If you suspect that all players are OB, then hit provisional shots before leaving your previous hitting zone.

#4, South boundary is the fence line. There is no longer OB between holes 3 & 4

#5 Fence line along east side of fairway

#8 South edge of the ditch running along the north side of the fairway.

#9 East edge of the ditch running along the west side of the fairway.

Keep up your pace of play with the group in front of your group. Play ready golf. If necessary, send one foursome forward to tee off on the next tee. MAXIMUM OF 2 MINUTES LOOKING FOR LOST BALL.

You are responsible for securing your own golf carts, there are 2 rentals available. You must have your own cart coordinated in order to play, we will not find you a cart the day of play.

DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS, ONLY GOLFERS AND COURSE STAFF ARE ALLOWED ON COURSE DURING PLAY. NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO RIDE ALONG AND FOLLOW GROUPS ON COURSE.

Be certain to fill your divots and repair your ball marks on the green.

All rules and regulation enforcement will be left to the discretion of Scott Community Golf Course Board.

The Jerry Buxton Challenge provided by Scott Community Foundation will pay \$1000 towards a hole-in-one contest. The first person to card a legitimate ace will receive \$1000.
