Registration. First round shotgun start (7:00 am & 12:30 pm Please be ready to play by 6:45 am and 12:15 pm). Evening meal for player and significant other will be served at Scott Community Golf Course Clubhouse at 5:45 pm for the morning teams, followed by the afternoon teams. Additional dinner tickets are available for \$30 per person and can be purchased at registration.

Sunday, July 19th

Final Round. Shotgun start (7:00 am & 12:30 pm – Please be ready to start by 6:45 am and 12:15 pm)

Pairings and tee times will be announced Saturday night – **NO SWITCHING OF TIMES ALLOWED**. Playing time ties (if any) will be determined by a Saturday's Scorecard playoff. If you can't play in the afternoon or morning on Sunday, please do not sign up for the tournament. Prizes will be mailed to team contact the following week.

ENTRY FEE - \$1000 per team (\$250 per player). **Teams with no members of Scott Community Golf Course must pay \$1100 for entry.** Entire entry fee is required in order to be considered for the tournament. **Applications will not be processed without the entry fee paid in full.** All attendees must be **21 years of age** by July 17th 2026.

TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SECURING YOUR OWN CART

The following criteria will be used to determine this year's participants:

- 1) Last year's Champions will receive priority. (Must have all 4 returning players)
- 2) Platinum Level (\$1,800) Sponsorship & Guaranteed Entry for one 4 member team
- 3) All Gold Level Sponsors (\$500). (80 points)
- 4) Silver Level Sponsors (\$350). (50 points)
- 5) Bronze Level Sponsors (\$200). (20 points)
- 6) Scott Community Golf Course Members. (25 points per member)
- 7) Returning teams with at least 3 returning players from the year prior will receive 1 point for each returning teammate.
- 8) Date Entry Received (e.g. entry received on 20th has priority over entry received on 30th, all other items being equal)
- 9) All other Teams who do not qualify (no points) by one of the above criteria will be drawn at random if any spots are open.
- 10) Automatic entry is provided to each current SCGC Board Member for one, four-person team. Entry is non-transferable and standard entry fees still apply.
